Overview of funding addressed (Europe/ Country / Region wide)



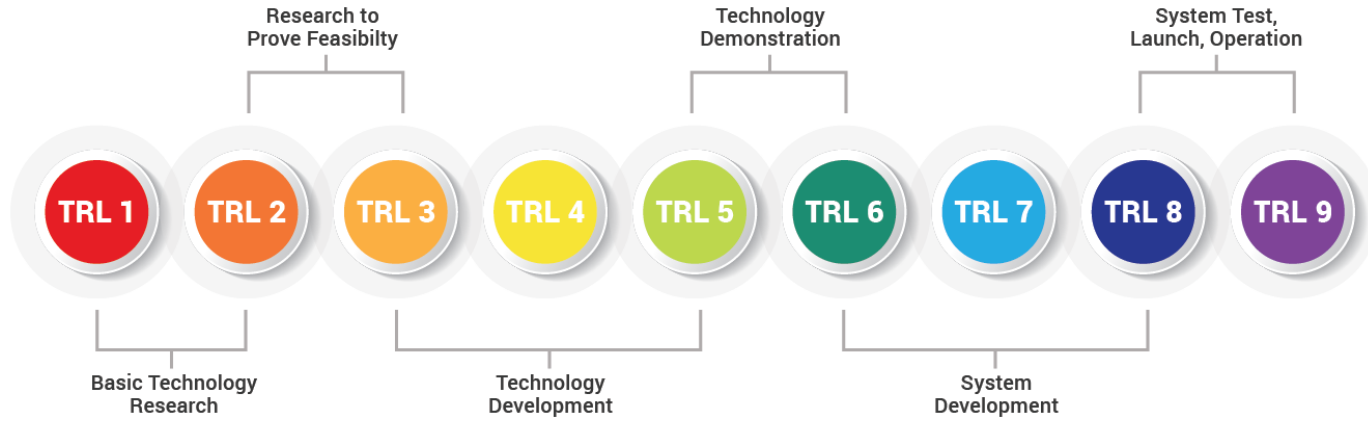

Spanish Regions

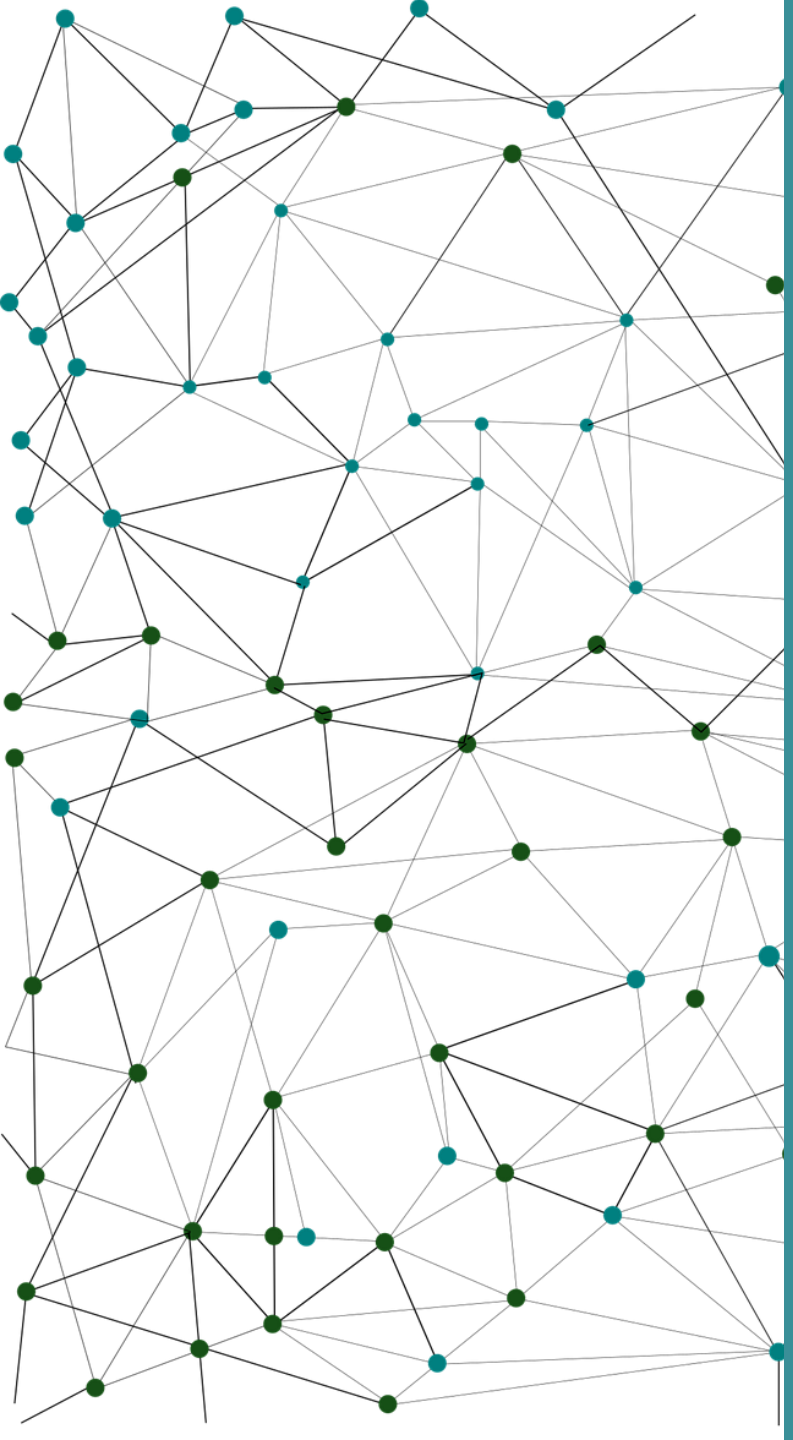

Single or collaborative project



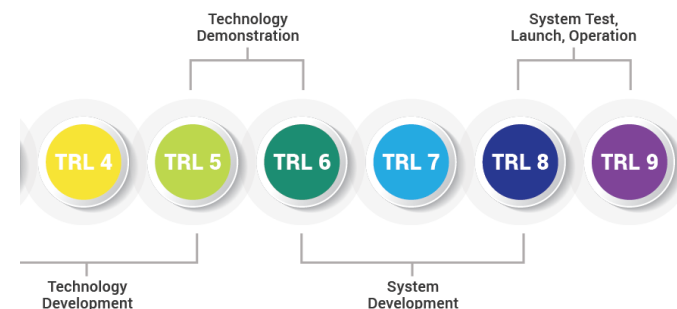

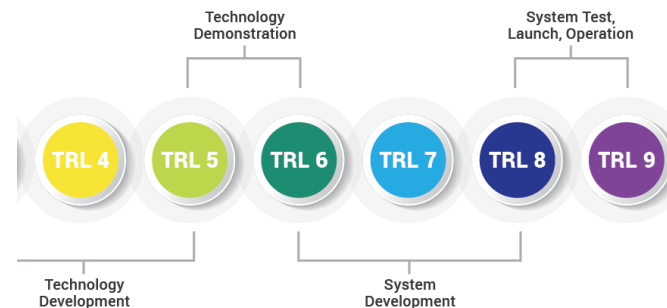

Name of the Call: R&D projects

Open: continuous **Close:** continuous

- **Beneficiaries:** individual companies (large companies are eligible) or consortia of companies
- **Consortium (or not):** individual companies or consortia of 2-6 companies
- **Aim of funding (expected results):** Projects implemented by companies and aimed at the creation and / or significant improvement of a production process, product or service that may include industrial research and experimental development activities. There are no restrictions on the sector or the technology to be developed.
- **Thematic:** R&D projects to develop or improve products, processes or services, without restrictions on the sector or the technology to be developed.
- **Type of support:** partially repayable loan
- **Budget and funding conditions:** Minimum budget of 175.000 €. Support up to 85% of the eligible budget. Non-repayable portion of 20-30%. Fixed interest rate: 1-year Euribor
- **Length expected of the project:** 12-36 months

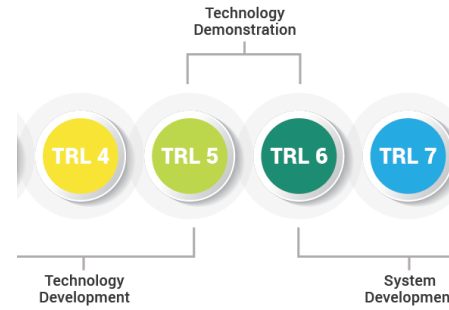


Name of the Call: Missions for Science and Innovation

Open: open (22 June 2022) **Close:** 5 September 2022

- **Beneficiaries:** companies
- **Consortium (or not):** Two types of projects and consortia: i) missions for large enterprises – consortium of 3-8 companies, led by a large enterprise and including one SME; ii) missions for SMEs – consortium of 3-6 companies, all SMEs, led by a medium enterprise.
- **Aim of funding (expected results):**
 - Support for cooperative pre-competitive research projects, led by companies, to achieve: i) relevant research that proposes solutions to cross-cutting and strategic challenges faced by the Spanish society; ii) improve the knowledge and technology base on which Spanish companies rely to compete; and iii) stimulate public-private cooperation.
- **Thematic:** several, including “Promoting a more sustainable agri-food sector adapted to the new conditions associated with climate change through the relevant use of advanced biotechnological tools”.
- **Type of support:** Grant
- **Budget and funding conditions:** Subsidy up to the maximum intensity limits: 65% Large Enterprise, 75% Medium Enterprise and 80% Small Enterprise.
 - Projects in category “missions for large enterprises”: Minimum eligible budget of 4-15 M€. Minimum eligible budget per company of 175 k€. Industrial research of at least 60% of the eligible budget. Subcontracting with Knowledge Generating Centres of at least 20% of the eligible budget.
 - Projects in category “missions for SMEs”: Minimum eligible budget of 1,5-3 M€. Minimum eligible budget per company of 175 k€. Minimum industrial research of 35% of the eligible budget. Subcontracting with Knowledge Generating Centres of at least 15% of the eligible budget.
- **Length expected of the project:** start in 2022. Completion: 31 December 2024 or 30 June 2025.

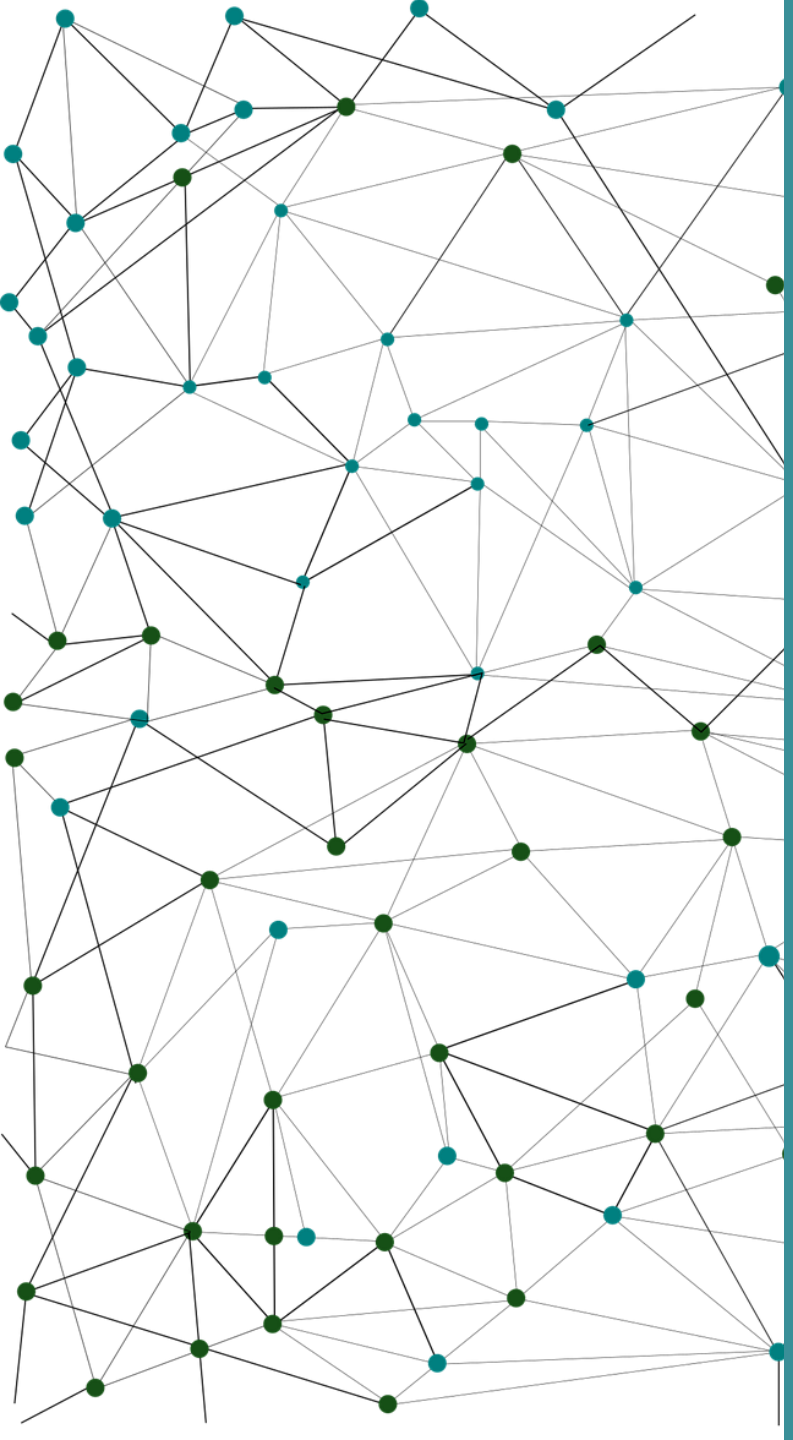




Name of the Call: RDI projects in strategic lines

Open: open (16 June 2022) **Close:** 5 July 2022

- **Beneficiaries:** research organisations and companies
- **Consortium (or not):** consortia of companies in collaboration with R&D organisations (public or private) (at least one company and one research organization)
- **Aim of funding (expected results):** support industrial research projects carried out in cooperation between enterprises and both public and private R&D actors, in order to respond to the challenges identified in the thematic priorities (topics).
- **Thematic:** several thematics, including Improving agricultural sustainability on a territorial scale based on agro-ecological principles and living laboratories; and Digital transition in the agri-food sector
- **Type of support:** Grants and loans
- **Budget and funding conditions:** budget between 400.000 €/ 2.000.000 €.
 - Companies: Loans of up to 95% of the bankable cost of the project
 - Research organisations: grants
- **Length expected of the project:** 3 years

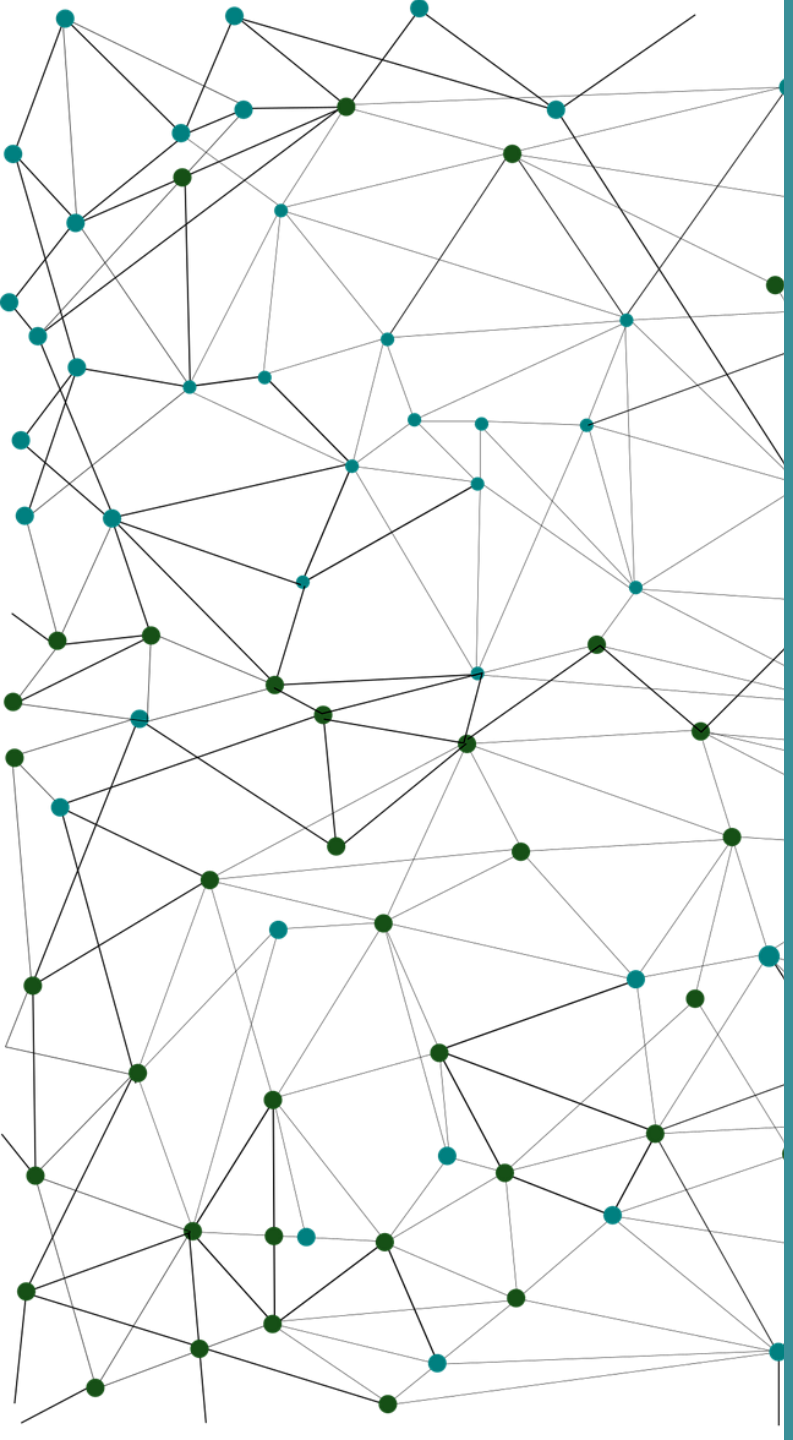

- Investments aimed at the transformation, marketing or development of products with agricultural origin.
- Investments destined to the transformation and commercialization of forestry products.
- Investments for the processing and marketing of fishery and aquaculture products.
